- 3. LGROW Spring Forum Recap
 - a. Over 150 people participated in the 2021 Forum. Planning for next year's Forum will start soon. The current plan for the 2022 Forum will be a hybrid between the previous year's one day event and the 11 day, 2021 active Forum.

- 4. Other Discussion
 - a. Subwatershed Updates
 - OCD, Sand Creek & Crockery Creek The OCD has received a 319 EGLE grant to address nonpoint source pollution in the Sand Creek and Crockery Creek watersheds, and to provide E. coli monitoring. This funding will be used to provide technical assistance, outreach and education, and cost-share for BMP's like cover crops, reduced tillage, filter strips, and repairs to failing septic systems.
 - ii. Coldbrook Creek Has recently finalized their logo and will be going to farmers markets and other local events to get more people in their communities involved with their watershed group. They are continuing they work with the TU Mayfly monitoring but are looking for base data to compare parameters.
 - Rush Creek –Rush Creek did not receive their grant to implement raingardens on church grounds. However, their contacts would be welcomed for the LGROW Sacred Grounds grant.
 - iv. Plaster Creek Is continuing their work with the "Green Team" of high students. They also have a "Supercrew" college students' who are working this year with green infrastructure maintance. They have also been busy applying for grants and planning for their future.
 - v. LGROW Site assessments for rainscaping program is live on our website again and we are back out giving site assessments. We have received another Sacred Grounds and will be looking for places of worship to work with. LGROW has lost of opportunities for volunteering two Whitecaps events July 24th and August 21st. Stream Girls will be occurring again at Blandford Nature Center, and more tree plantings will happen fall. Dragon boat races are coming back, September 25th at Canal Park.
